Refrigerant Management
(Adopted October 20, 2011)

- 1.0 **Management of High Global Warming Potential Refrigerants For Stationary Sources.** Pursuant to the California Global Warming Solutions Act of 2006 (Health & Safety Code, Sections 38500 et. seq.), the California Air Resources Board (CARB) has promulgated Greenhouse Gas Mitigation and Control measures, including a regulation to reduce emissions of high global warming potential refrigerants from stationary, non-residential refrigeration equipment and from the installation and servicing of stationary refrigeration and air-conditioning appliances using high-GWP refrigerants. For purposes of regulating such refrigerant emissions, the District hereby adopts CARB's regulation for Management of High Global Warming Potential Refrigerants for Stationary Sources, as set forth at Title 17, Division 3, Article 4, Subarticle 5.1 (§§ 95380-95398), and all amendments thereto, incorporated by reference as though set forth fully herein. A complete copy of said regulation hereby adopted is filed and available for use and examination by the public at the District office.
